



The Eastern School of Acupuncture and Traditional Medicine's admissions standards reflect the institution's commitment to maintaining the highest standards of educational excellence. ESATM's commitment is to enroll highly qualified and capable individuals who will become leaders and prominent proponents of the field of acupuncture and traditional medicine.

A completed application includes the following:

1. A completed online application for admissions www.esatm.edu
2. A non-refundable \$50 application fee. Application fee credit card forms are available on www.esatm.edu
3. Applicants to the MSAc program are required to have a minimum of 60 college credits in any subject. (GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENT: While ESATM will accept 60 college credits to enter the program, the Federal Aid requirements have changed for students with under 90 credits at ESATM, therefore students entering the MSAc program with under 90 credits will not be eligible for financial aid until year two of the acupuncture program. The state of NJ still requires a bachelor's degree independent of an applicant's acupuncture education to apply for NJ state licensing. NY, PA, and CT do not require a bachelor's degree to obtain licensure).
 - Official transcripts from post-secondary institutions must be sent directly from the institution to the admissions department.
 - Applicants should provide copies of professional licenses. Professional licenses may include but are not restricted to M.D., D.C., P.T., R.N., and M.T. **(you are not required to have a medical license to enter the MSAc program)**-
 - All post-secondary education outside the US must be evaluated by the World Education Service (WES) and sent directly to the admissions department. www.wes.org
4. Applicants must supply three letters of reference from individuals knowledgeable about the applicant's potential for success in a graduate-level academic program. Applicants are encouraged to seek references mainly from health professionals, educators, employers, clients, etc. Please contact the admissions department if you require further information.
5. Applicants must submit a 2-4 page assigned topic essay, in MLA or APA format with a minimum of 3 cited, credible references. Please email the admissions office for your assigned topic. kwilliams@esatm.edu

All applicants under the age of 30 must submit their vaccination records (applicants can utilize a copy of their post-secondary school vaccination records) with their application.
