

Upcoming Continuing Education Seminars with Frances Goodwin, L.Ac.

Course Topic: <u>Pediatric Tui Na</u>

Presenter: Frances Goodwin has had a family practice in acupuncture in New York City since 1991, with a focus on pediatrics. In addition to acupuncture, she is nationally certified in Chinese herbology. She is a licensed massage therapist and has studied The Alexander Technique since early 1980s. Her practice includes acupuncture, herbs, tuina, and movement therapy.

Program Description: This course will cover principles, techniques and approaches that can aid practitioners in successfully applying Tui-na to their young patients. Because children are a unique demographic with increased sensitivity to needles and moxa, manual therapy can be a great tool to circumvent some of the therapeutic challenges they present to successful, comfortable treatment. Hence, the goal of this course is to endow attendees with the necessary toolkit to competently administer Tui-na manual therapies in clinical settings where it presents as the expedient therapeutic option.

Prerequisite: Attendees are asked to embark on a daily practice (Qigong, Meditation, Yoga, Grounding, etc) for 2 weeks before course.
