Presenter: Jeffrey Yuen comes directly from a Daoist lineage and trained under the Daoist priest, Yuen, learning among other healing arts, Chinese herbal medicine. Yuen was invited by NCCAOM to be among a group of prominent practitioners, to write and review questions during the development of the NCCAOM herbal exam and also served on their Finalization Committee

Course Topic: Nourishing Yin with Acupuncture

Program Description: One of the reasons for the historical decline of acupuncture in China was the growing belief that acupuncture could not nourish yin, given there was actually no exchange or “injection” of yin from metallic needles. Yet, at the same time, there were and still are clinicians who actually “believe” that acupuncture can induce the nourishment of yin from various perspectives, ranging from the theories of transformation to the reaction of the metals within the needles and their impact on the “substance” of the body. This seminar will explore the dynamics of acupuncture and its role in the nurturing, engendering, and nourishing yin.
