Clinical Auriculotherapy - A Clinicians Introduction to Basic Auricular Medicine

Course Description:

Basic Auricular Medicine is a training that allows serious students of Auricular Medicine to familiarize themselves with the reasoning behind the use of Auricular Medicine in difficult diagnostic cases and also to show body acupuncture clinicians the options available diagnostically in Auricular Medical Techniques. In trying to satiate the needs of auricular specialists and those just hoping to incorporate ear acupuncture in their treatment regimen. Auricular purists will use this training to fine-tune the basics needed to achieve clinical success while those using auricular sparingly will discover the potential this therapy presents to those willing to learn its' secrets'!

Day 1 will build from the initial seminar taught presenting the German microsystem of the ear, how it came to be and what makes it so unique. More practice time will be spent on point location and treatment devices used in Auricular Medicine. A lengthy explanation will be shown in proper use of auricular devices such as pointfinder/stimulators, lasers, needles and seeds and benefits of each. By the end of the day it is hoped all attendees will feel competent in treating ear points in addition to their regular treatment.

Day 2 will discover the ways in which patients become chronically ill and blockages to treatment which commonly create our most difficult patients. In knowing the deviations pathology can create in our patients we have hoped that armed with this knowledge, clinicians can use proven techniques to interrupt the process by which a patient becomes a chronically ill dilemma. Whether you choose to continue in the 4 level courses or not this second training translates to everyone's practice and will benefit all of us who work in our field.

You should come armed with your list of difficult cases and we will discuss them in class. Last but not least the basic terms used in Auricular medicine will be taught with examples shown and how it can translate to your needs.

Prerequisites: attendees should have previously had Tom Corbin's Introduction to German Auricular Therapy seminar or be versed in the European Auricular System.
