

A completed transfer application includes the following:

- Applicants must complete an online application for admission www.esatm.edu and remit with a non-refundable \$75.00 application fee.(\$75.00 fee is waived for transfer applicants who requested a transfer evaluation prior to applying into the MSAc program at the fee of \$75.00).
- Applicants to the Eastern School are required to have a minimum of 60 college credits and must submit official transcripts from the institution(s) of higher learning that they attended along with copies of professional licenses, if applicable. GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENT: While ESATM will accept 60 college credits to enter the program, the Federal Aid requirements have changed for students with under 90 credits at ESATM, therefore students entering the MSAc program with under 90 credits will not be eligible for financial aid until year two of the acupuncture program. The state of NJ still requires a bachelor's degree independent of an applicant's acupuncture education to apply for NJ state licensing. NY, PA, and CT do not require a bachelor's degree to obtain licensure). Professional licenses may include but are not restricted to-M.D., D.C., P.T., R.N., and L.M.T. All post-secondary education outside the US must be evaluated by the World Education Service (WES) www.wes.org.
- If an applicant has 4 credits in Human or General Biology within ten years of applying with a grade of 2.0 or greater the course may be accepted as the ESATM Biology requirement unless they are a licensed health care professional* in which case the ten year requirement may be waived. All applicants who have not taken a 4 credit Human or General Biology course may elect to CLEP their Biology or take a 4 credit course at any accredited post-secondary school **prior** to entering the acupuncture program. Applicants also have the option of taking their Biology requirement at ESATM either prior to entering the program or in their **first** year of full time acupuncture program matriculation at ESATM.
- Applicants must supply three letters of reference from individuals knowledgeable about the
 applicant's potential for success in a graduate level academic program. Applicants are encouraged
 to seek references mainly from health professionals, educators, and employers, however letters
 from other individuals are also acceptable. You may contact the admissions department to inquire
 more information regarding referral letters.
- Applicants must submit a 2-4 page topic related essay. Please contact the admissions office for your assigned topic. Essay must be in either MLA or APA format.

All applicants under the age of 30 must submit their vaccination records (applicants can utilize a copy of their post-secondary school vaccination records) with their application.

Please note: All prospective students who intend on utilizing financial aid are strongly urged to fill out their FAFSA prior to applying to the acupuncture program for a free financial aid consultation. Please refer to the financial aid sheet in this packet for further information.
